

GUIDELINES FOR SUB-COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION SELECTION AND PRIORITIZATION

- **Each subcommittee will review recommendations in the appropriate category.**
- **Conference call(s) will be hosted by DEA staff.**
- **One member of each subcommittee will present the selected recommendations to the Task Force at the December 10 meeting. A power point presentation will be prepared by DEA staff using the information on the Task Force Subcommittee Report—Selected Recommendations Form. Presentations should be no more than 20 minutes in length.**

As you review the submitted recommendation, the following questions should be considered:

Will this recommendation improve the quality of life for people with dementia?

Will this recommendation improve the quality of care for people with dementia?

Does this recommendation fit into one of the four categories identified?

Does this recommendation address a specific problem?

Does this recommendation demonstrate an improvement in efficiency in the care of people with Alzheimer's Disease?

Does this recommendation fit into any of the items listed in SF489 4(2)b?

1. The type, cost and availability of dementia services.
2. Dementia-specific training requirements for long-term care staff.
3. Quality care measures for residential care facilities.
4. The capacity of public safety and law enforcement agencies to respond to person with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders.
5. The availability of home and community-bases resources for persons with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders and respite care to assist families.
6. An inventory of long-term care dementia care units.
7. The adequacy and appropriateness of geriatric-psychiatric unites for persons with behavior disorders associated with Alzheimer's disease and related dementia.
8. Assisted living residential options for persons with dementia.
9. State support of research of Alzheimer's disease and related disorders through the state's institutions of higher education and other resources.

The Task Force Sub-committee should also determine a tier level for each recommendation:

Tier 1 This task should be started within the next 1-2 years.

Tier 2 This task should be started within the next 3-5 years.

Tier 3 This task should be started within the next 6-10 years.

Upon completion of the recommendation selection process, the information should be entered on the Task Force Subcommittee Report—Selected Recommendations Form
